

What's in a Name???

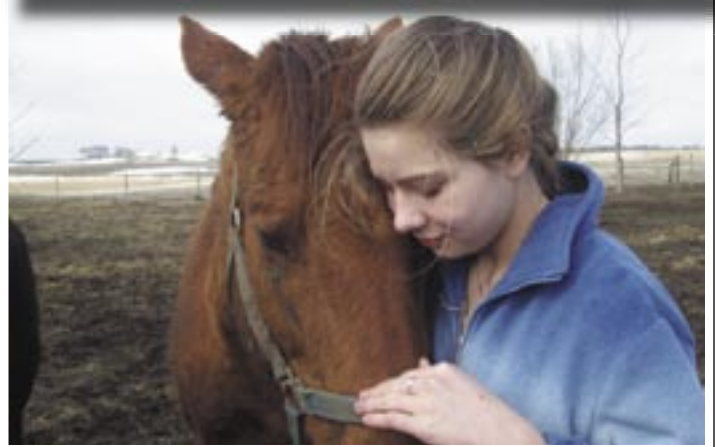

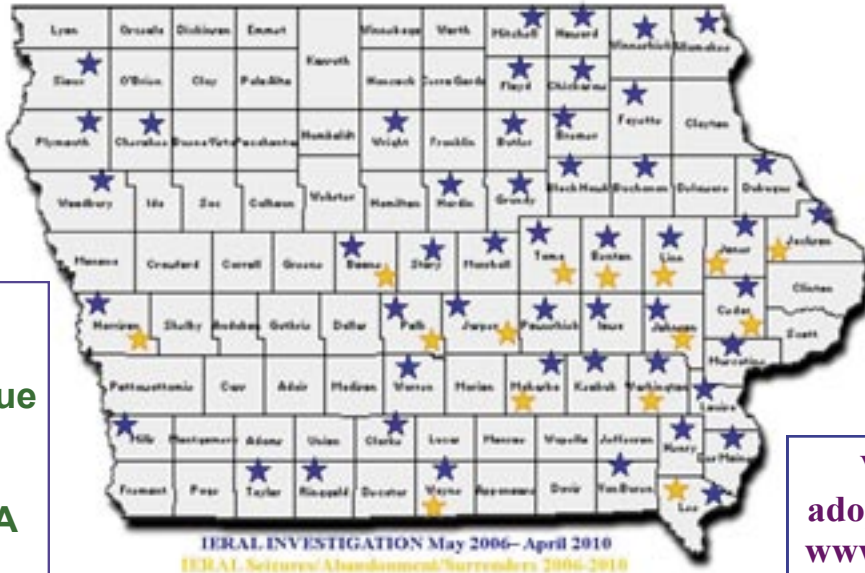
Another great ending and second chance of life for one of our rescued horse, and in this case, horse(s).
